TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SUBSCRIPTIONS, JOINING FEES AND STANDING ORDERS

- We reserve the right in our absolute discretion, to decline any application for membership without given reason for doing so and in such case any subscriptions paid in advance will be refunded.
- In applying for membership the member understands that annual subscriptions are non-refundable. Members paying on a standing order basis commit to a minimum of 12 month contract at the start of the membership and on any subsequent renewals after 12 months. It is the responsibility of the members to ensure Standing Orders are implemented with their bank for the agree date on application. Failure to do so may result in instant termination of membership.
- Membership is NOT transferable.
- The England Golf and Worcestershire County Golf Union Affiliation Fee is included In the annual fee.
- Membership benefits apply only to the holder of the membership and these cannot be transferred to any other individual.
- Corporate Membership is only available to registered companies, and must be invoiced back to the company. A VAT number must be provided.
- Proof of address is required for Joint Membership
- Proof of address is required for Country Membership
- We reserve the right to amend pricing of Membership and Membership options at any time. Bransford Golf Club reserves the right to increase any payments as a result of government increase in tax such as VAT

CANCELLATION OF MEMBERSHIP

- A member's membership shall continue in force after the first 12 months, for an indefinite period. A member may terminate his or her membership at any time giving us no less than 3 full calendar months written notice in advance. We may terminate the membership without liability to the member at any time and for any reason giving you less than 3 months notice.

CREDITS

- Unused credits can be carried over at the end of year upon subsequent renewal. However. If membership is not continued any credit balance will be forfeited. Credit is non transferable to other members. Credits can be used for members own golf, pro-shop purchases, and buggy hire but cannot be used against competition entry fees.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

- Members must carry their membership card at all times in the golf club. It is a legal requirement for all players to sign in/swipe card prior to play.

CLOSURE

- We will endeavour to keep Bransford Golf Club operating during our opening hours as published. From time to time the Course or certain facilities within the club may be shut due to cleaning, repairs or necessary maintenance and for reasons beyond our control eg. weather conditions. Whilst we endeavour to minimise any disruption and give due warning in advance, we have no liability to members in doing so and no extension or refund will be given.

BEHAVIOUR OF MEMBERS

- We reserve the right to refuse and/or cancel membership forthwith if any member, in our opinion, causes a nuisance to other members or guests of Bransford Golf Club or the Bank House Hotel.

MEMBER GUESTS

- Members are entitled to three visiting guests per tee time at a reduced rate; guests must be accompanied by the paying member. All Members and guests must adhere to the club dress code shown on our website, failure to do so will result in yourself and guests being unable to play.

LIABILITY

- Bransford Golf Club or The Bank House Hotel will not accept any liability for any accident or injury (including fatality) to any member or guest that may occur on the premises or within the grounds of The Bank House other than liability which may arise from the negligence of The Bank House Hotel, Bransford golf Club or its staff. Any accidents must be reported immediately to a member of staff. Bransford Golf Club are not responsible for any loss or theft that may occur on our premises.

PERSONAL DETAILS

- Members must agree to keep reception up to date with any changes in their personal details such as e-mail address, home address and contact telephone number.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- Smoking and vaping are not permitted in the Clubhouse building. Members may not bring their own food or drink to consume at Bransford Golf Club. Members who are, or who appear to be, under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted to access Bransford Golf Club.
- The management's decision is final and cannot be put to appeal. Any member wishing to make a complaint should do so to the golf manager in writing.

HANDICAP

Although Bransford Golf Club does not impose a handicap restriction we do require all golfers to have attained a suitable level of ability to play our course and have a good knowledge of the rules and etiquette of the game and respect other golfer's ability.

TEE TIME BOOKINGS AND CANCELLATIONS

Tee times can be booked up to two weeks in advance. It is advisable to book all tee times in advance to avoid disappointment. You are expected to arrive on the tee 10 minutes prior to your tee time.

Cancellation for any tee times must be 48 hours in advance prior to TeeTime. We reserve the right to charge the prevailing guest rate for any non-cancelled reservations.

BUGGY RULES

Buggies may only be driven by those over the age of 18 years. Buggies MUST be kept to the paths at all times. A Waiver Form form must be signed in the pro shop before taking a Buggy out on the course.

DRESS CODE

The following is considered appropriate attire for the Golf Course:

Collared or turtle neck shirts with sleeves.

Full length trousers.

Tailored shorts with sports socks.

Ladies may wear golf skirts, mid-length trousers and sleeveless shirts.

Golf shoes must be worn.

Should a member of your group be inappropriately dressed, we will refuse them access to the golf course.

BEHAVIOUR

Disorderly conduct in the Clubhouse or on the Course will not be accepted at any time. Smoking and vaping are not permitted in the Clubhouse building. Members may not bring their own food or drink to consume at Bransford Golf Club. Members who are, or who appear to be, under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted to access Bransford Golf Club
